Thos B Haughton - Allen & Lafayette Haughton to have one half of same & Rev Thomas B Haughton one half to them and their heirs for ever. but if either Allen or Lafayette Haughton die without heirs of their bodies living at his death then the other is to take his one half share, and if both said Allen & Lafayette die without leaving any of his body then living then & in this case to the said Rev Thomas B Haughton.

Item 2nd I give and devise and bequest all my other property, real and personal which I have now and may hereafter acquire to the same devise & under the same limitations declared in Item first hereof.

I appoint and nominate the Rev Thomas B Haughton as executor of this my last will and testament. Signed sealed published by the testator Anna N. Irwin in the presence of her and of each other by her request.
