In the name of God. Amen. I Frederick Spruill of the County of Washington in the State of North Carolina, being of sound disposing mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last will & Testament, hereby revoking all other wills heretofore made.

First I desire & direct my remains to be buried in a decent and Christian manner at the discretion of my Executor and Executor hereinafter to be appointed.

Second I direct that my just debts be paid by my said Executor and Executor in such manner as is legal and as they may think best for all concerned in my estate.

Third I bind to my beloved wife Mary C. Spruill for and during her life of widowhood the following property viz, my tract of land whereon I live also all of my Cattle, horses, hogs, sheep, farming utensils of every kind, also all my household and kitchen furniture, for and during her life of widowhood as aforesaid.

Fourth I will & direct that my said wife shall cultivate the land or cause the same to be done, to enable her to provide food & sustenance for my children & she to keep them free from expense, my said wife shall have right to make sales of such portion of the crops & stock as shall be necessary to purchase such things as shall be necessary for her support & family.

Fifth I give & devise unto my children in common the tract of land whereon I live, to be taken in possession at the death of my said wife, to share their heirs & assigns forever.

Sixth I direct that the movable property mentioned in the third item of this will, shall go to my children equally at the death of my said wife.

Seventh I will & direct that if my said wife shall marry again that a sale of all the property herein mentioned shall take place & the proceeds to be divided between each of my children & my said wife.

Finally I nominate & appoint my Brother James I. Spruill Executor & my wife Mary C. Spruill Executor to this my last will & Testament.
