I Joseph D. Newbury, of the above said State and County being of sound mind but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this to be my last will and testament -

1st My executor herein after named shall give my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my friends and relatives and pay all funeral expenses and my just debts out of the first monies which may come into his hands belonging to my estate.

2nd My executor shall sell all my property, real and personal, of whatever kind, for cash or on six months credit, which ever he may think best, and if on said credit, then good and ample security, to be approved by my executors shall be given, and the proceeds of the sale shall be disposed of as follows:

3rd I give, devise and bequeath the residue of all monies in my executors hands from whatever source derived to Denwood Newbury son of Edward Newbury, D. H. Newbury Sarah Blant wife of Levi Blant Theophilus Newbury Arthur Newbury Joseph D. Newbury, son of Louis, Anna Nochim Newbury and George Newbury to be equally divided between them, share and share alike, after the said named parties shall account for what I have hitherto advanced them, as contained in the next item of this will.

4th For the purpose of preventing uncertainty I hereto append the amounts advanced and for which the said parties are to account in the distribution of my estate. That is to say D. H. Newbury is to account for (\$300) three hundred dollars Sarah Blant is to account for (\$200) two hundred dollars Theophilus Newbury is to account for (\$100) one hundred dollars and Arthur Newbury is to account for (\$100) one hundred dollars.

5th I hereby appoint and constitute D. H. Newbury my lawful executor to all intents and purposed to execute this my last will and testament according to its true intent and meaning and hereby revoke all other wills and testaments heretofore made and declare them utterly void.

And this deponent further saith that at the said time when the said testator subscribed his name to the said last will as aforesaid and, at the time of deponent subscribing his name to the said last will as aforesaid as attesting witness thereto as aforesaid, the said Jas D. Newbury was of sound mind and memory of full age to execute a will and was not under any restraint to the knowledge information or belief of this deponent. And further this deponent say not
