 be at the time of my death. And after the death
 of my beloved named wife my will is that all
 my said property shall be publicly sold by my
 second executor and equally divided among my
 lawful heirs. And I do nominate constitute and appoint
 my said wife first executor of this my last will
 and testament hereby revoking and making void all
 and every other will or wills at any time theretofore
 made by me and do declare this to be my last will and
 testament.

And I constitute and appoint as my second executor my
 trusty friend Jas. Phus. W. Snell to publicly administer
 and sell all my said property at public sale and pay
 all my & her just debts and then equally divide the
 remainder among my lawful heirs.

In witness whereof the said Jordan W. Snell have
 hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal.
