

North Carolina, Washington County.

I, Shadrick P. Palin, of the County of Washington and State of North Carolina, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this my last Will and Testament.

First. My executors hereinafter named, shall give my body a decent burial, suitable to the wishes of my friends and relatives, shall fence in the grave of my wife and me with an iron fence or of some other suitable material, place a marker or suitable memorial to my grave, and pay all funeral expenses, together with all my just debts out of the first money which may come into his hands.

Second. I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved daughter, Lumiger Jones, that certain tract or parcel of land in Skinnerville township, Washington County, which is a part of the land purchased by me from C. B. Davis by deed dated January 24, 1824, and of public record in the office of Register of Deeds for Washington County in Book No. 82 page 311, and which is bounded and particularly described as follows:- Beginning at the main road in Ed Staley's line; thence running northwardly along said line to Glade Branch, a gully; thence eastwardly along the said Branch to an Oak in the edge of same in J. R. Cahoon's line; thence southwardly along a line of marked trees to an Oak at the main road; thence westwardly along the said road 280 yards to the first station, containing 8 acres, more or less.

It is my will and desire that the said tract of land be given to and held by my daughter, Lumiger Jones, free and clear of any and all liens or other claims which my estate may have upon the same and that the same shall in no way be liable or subject to any claims which my estate may have against my said daughter.

Third. I give, devise and bequeath also to my said daughter, Lumiger Jones, all of the excess of five Hundred Dollars which may be due to me or my estate at the time of my death by virtue of that certain claim which I hold against my daughter, Lumiger Jones, and her husband, Tom Jones, and which is secured by a mortgage executed by them to me on the tract of land on which they now live, to the end that not more than Five Hundred Dollars may be collected on the said claim, plus such interest as may accrue on the said sum of Five Hundred Dollars from the date of this my last will and Testament. It is especially my will and desire that my daughter, Lumiger Jones, and her husband, Tom Jones, shall not be personally responsible for the payment of the aforesaid indebtedness of Five Hundred Dollars, but that the payment of same shall be secured only by a lien on that part of the tract of land now occupied by them which lies on the north side of Glade Branch.

Fourth. I give and devise to my grandsons Shadrick Palin and Isaac Palin, share and share alike that part of my home place, adjoining the lands of Ann Blount

and described as follows:- Beginning in Ann Blount's line at a ditch; thence running southwardly along the said ditch to the swamp and across the swamp to Bird Patrick's line; thence eastwardly along the said line to the lands now occupied by my daughter, Indiana Butte; thence northwardly along the last mentioned lands to and along a ditch near the house in which the said Indiana Butte now lives to a cross ditch near the said house; thence eastwardly along said cross ditch to a lane; thence northwardly along the lane to the public road and across said road and along the line where the lane formerly stood to Joseph Patrick's line; thence westwardly along Joseph Patrick's line to Ann Blount's line; thence southwardly along Ann Blount's line to the public road and the point of beginning. For further description of the lands herein devised from my home tract reference can be made to a map which I have heretofore had made of the same and which is hereto annexed.

Fifth. I give and devise to my beloved daughter, Indiana Butte, that part of my home place where she now lives, containing Twenty five acres, more or less.

Sixth. I give and devise to my son, Isaac Palin, that part of my home place which is now used and occupied by him, containing twenty acres, more or less.

Seventh. I give and devise to my granddaughter, Francis Rouson and Robens Creekmore, share and share alike all the rest and residue of my land not hereinbefore devised, and which has not heretofore been allotted to and occupied by my beneficiaries hereinbefore named.

Eighth. I give and bequeath to my son Isaac Palin the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to be paid out of the claim hereinbefore mentioned against a part of the lands of my daughter, Lumiger Jones, and her husband, Tom Jones.

Ninth. I give and bequeath to my son, Clinton Palin, Two Hundred Dollars to be paid out of the said claim.

Tenth. I give and bequeath to my grandsons, Isaac Palin and Shadrick Palin, Fifty Dollars each, to be paid out of the aforesaid claim.

Eleventh. All the rest and residue of my property I give, devise and bequeath to my son, Isaac Palin, and to my daughter, Indiana Butte and Lumiger Jones, and to my grandchildren, Isaac Palin, Shadrick Palin, Francis Rouson and Robens Creekmore, in the proportion of two parts to each of my said children and one part to each of my said grandchildren.

Twelfth. I hereby constitute and appoint my sons, Clinton Palin, and Isaac Palin, and my daughter, Indiana Butte and Lumiger Jones, my lawful executors, to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same, and every part and clause thereof, who will act without hind-




