This Cause coming on for trial at this term, before His Honor and a jury duly sworn and empanelled, upon the issue certified from the Clerk of this Court upon the two Caveats filed, to wit: Is the paper writing propounded and each and every part thereof, the last Will & Testament of W. J. Whitaker deceased? And the jury having answered the issue submitted as above set out, yes and by said Answer found for their verdict that said paper writing and every part proved theretofore, is the Last will of said Testator. And it appearing to the Court that all parties properly interested in the cause to wit the heirs at law of said Testator and the various devisees and legatees are properly before this Court by due & lawful service: it is therefore on motion of Stubbs & Stubbs, Van C. Martin & Ward & Skinner, Counsel for Pro-  
pounders adjudged that said paper writing is the Last Will & Testament of W. J. Whitaker, and same is therefore ordered & adjudged to be probated in solemn form.

The said Will is therefore remanded to the Clerk of this Court and he directed to record and docket same and to certify a copy thereof under his official seal, with a copy of the Caveats and of this the record in this cause and this judgment to the Superior Court of Martin County, and that same be indexed according to law in both offices.

Further proceedings toward the execution of said will, will proceed from this Court and the Executors are directed to file their reports to this Court and to file duplicates thereof with the Clerk of Superior Court of Martin County.
