her heirs for ever, all the residue and remainder of my Estate
of what kind ~~it may be~~ ^{it may be} after my debts & legacies are paid I
do give unto my loving wife Avey Ruffin during her life, & after her
decease to be equally divided amongst my fifteen Purile Deceases
children, I do hereby Nominate. Constitute & appoint my
loving wife Avey Ruffin & Wm. DeLoach. Executors & Executrix
of this my last will & Testament. Revoking & annulling
and making void. all other former wills & gifts by me made
except a deed of gift dated the day & year above written
and declare this only to be my last will & Testament.
