of my estate which I have before given her by a Deed of gift, and
Date 14th Sept: 1779. which Article the said gift will fully make
affair to her & her Heir forever. Item I give unto Betsy
Bloodworth daughter of Mr. Bloodworth & McLachlin wife, one
feather bed & furniture, one mare colt called Pleasure, to her and
her Heirs for ever, all the residue and remainder of my estate to be
of what kind & nature soever, after my debts & legacies are paid &
lend unto my loving wife Lucy Ruffin during her life, & after her
decease to be equally divided amongst my sisters Purdy Deloach
& children, I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint my
loving wife Lucy Ruffin & Mr. Deloach Executrix & Executrix
of this my last will & Testament. Revoking & annuling
and making void all other former wills & gifts by me made
except a Deed of gift dated the day & year above written
and declare this only to be my last will & Testament.
