of Wayne County in the State of North Carolina
Calling to mind the mortality of my Body
Knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
Die do make and ordain this my last will and
Testament and first of all I commend my soul
Into the hands of god that gave it and my Body
To the Earth to be Buried in a Christian manner
at the Discretion of my Executors Nothing
Doubting But at the general Resurrection I shall
Receive the same again by the mighty Power of
god and as touching such worldly Estate as
It hath pleased god to Bless me within this
Life I give and Dispose in manner and form as
following. first of all I lend to my beloved
Wife Christian Barnes five Negroes Jack in
Gil Ben and Grace with fourteen head of Cattle and
Twenty head of sheep and four feather Beds and
furniture and the use of my plantation and fifty
Hogs and all my house hold goods with two horses
Bridles and saddles and forty pounds in money During
her natural Life or widowhood and after her Decease
To be Divided in manner and form as follows -
I give and bequeath to my son Sydney Barnes
one Negro Boy named Ben and also one
third of my Still - I give to my son Samuel
Barnes half my Still and ten pounds hard
money I give to my son Benjamin Barnes
five shillings Sterling I give to my three
Daughters Elizabeth Daniel Christian former
Moreover

Gilpea - farmer one Negro woman named
Gin to be equally divided between them
I give to my daughter Bardsheba homes one
Negro boy by the name of Isaac I give my
Son John Barnes my plantation and one
Negro fellow named Jack and one feather
bed and furniture - - - - -

I also give to my grand son Joseph Daniel
son of Joseph and Mary Daniel one Negro
woman named Zill. also I give to my grand
son John Barnes son of Simon Barnes one
feather bed and furniture and the remainder
part of my estate after the decease of my
wife Christian Barnes is to be equally
divided amongst all my children

I also constitute and appoint Simon

Barnes and Samuel Barnes my Executors

of this my last will and testament
bearing ^{all other} witness by me made before

last will and testament in witness
