Thorough-Lane Swamp During her Natural
Life for Widowhood And at her death or Marriage
to be Returned to my Daughter Anna Bask
not allowing any more Land to be cleared on
the Side of the Swamp where the Plantation is
nor any Use made of Oak Timber, I Also Give
and Bequeath to my Beloved Wife Alice Bask
to her Heirs & Assigns forever One Negro
Man named Big Thank One Negro Woman
named Lucy Two Feather Beds and Furniture
One Horrel Horse & Collar Bridle & Saddle
the mare known by the name of Sorrell & my
Bald Horse the Stock of Cattle Running at
the Place the Number being Twenty four head
Five Hens & pigs and Bacon or pork sufficient
for the first Year & Sixty Bushels of Corn
Five Cows and Lambs Two Pots & pot hooks
One Shillet One Traying Pan One half of
my Spouter knives & forks & crockery Ware.

And one half of the Cuck Two plow one Ox
One grubbing hoe & Two Weeding hoes Two
Cheese Table & half Dozzen Chairs One Linen
and one Walloy Wheel One Tub Two pails Two
Digging One room and Cears One Hundred Weight
of Seed Cotton
And fifty Weight of Swingled flax And Fifty Pounds
to be laid out in Building her a Dwelling House
on the plantation above mentioned.

Secondly I Give and Bequeath to Judiah Foley &
his Heir forever Two Hundred Pounds to be laid
out in two young Negroes, also One young Shide-
horse I am now Rescive Named Hammond
Thirdly & Lastly I Give and Bequeath to my Belov'd
Daughter Anna Oak and his Heir forever the
Whole of my Land & Plantations and all my Town
Lots and the Remainder of my Negroes vizt V. Herbert
Little Frank, Jem, Rab, Mill, Jack, Hanny, Simon,
George, & Ned, Hannah, Rose, Floro, Amia,
Nell, Pine, Kate, Doll Lett, Little Rose James & Mary
and all my Debts due to me or hereafter shall become
Due with all my Stock of every kind and all my
Household Goods Plantation Tools and all other of
my Estate whatever in whose hands Carekeeping or
Custody whatever the same can or may be found
Further my Will is that my hereafter Named Exors
shall yearly Rent out my Mill and Lands in diffi-
ent Tracts or parcels as shall see Cause having the
Mill Houses and Plantations kept in Good Repair
not suffering any Land to be cleared by Oak
Hemlock to be cut down nor deaded, likewise to
Feed out the Negroes yearly, and to sell the Remai-
der of my Estate at six Months Credit except on
Mortgage & Call known by the name of Flag

My Bed & Furniture Bowler and Crochery Ware
one Chest & Books and to keep the Money
during their lives after my just Debts & Legacies
is paid on Interest untill my said
Daughter Anna Case Marries or Dives to the
Age of Twenty One Years. Also it is my Will
that my beloved Wife has the Use of said Hannah
Cott George Little Rose James Ned and Mary
During her Widowhood or until such time as my
said Daughter Anna Case Marries or Dives to
the Age of Twenty One Years. Provided that my said
Wife will raise & clothe the Children that now is
Born or hereafter shall be Born by the Female
Nurses aforesaid. Taking those that is to be Born
at the Age of one Year.

Furthermore I Impower and Authorise Ex^{rs} to sell
the Remainder of my Estate and without calling on
any Sheriff whatsoever But if they see Cause to
employ the Sheriff of the County or any other Person
they think proper to Allow them Twenty Shilling
per Day for selling and taking Return to Court
on Oath. Further it is my Will that my Daughter
Anna Case be raised & schooled at the Discretion
of my Ex^{rs} And I Appoint Nominate Ordain
& constitute Uriah Case Col^o William Dickson
& Needham Whitfield Ex^{rs} of this my last
Will and Testament And I hereby Revoke
and Disannull all former Will or Wills hereto
said by me made Acknowledging this to be my
last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the
said Andrew Case Sen^r have hereunto set my
Hand and Seal this 30th Day of October 1790
