The fifteenth day of March in the Year of our Lord One Thousand seven Hundred and Ninety one I Jesse Krum of the State of North Carolina & County of Wayne being very sick and weak of body but of a perfect mind and Memory thank the Ever Giver unto God for the same, and calling to mind the mortality of my Body and knowing that it is Appointed for all Men once to die. Do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say Principally, and first of all I Give and Recommend my Soul into the Hands of God that gave it And for my Body I Recommend it to the earth to be Buried in a Christian like & decent manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall Receive it, Same again by the mighty Power of God, and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath Pleased God to bless me in this life I Give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and Form.

Imprimis I Give to my well beloved Wife Zilpha (during) her natural life or Widowhood Two thirds of all my lands Including the Houses and Plantation my Father and Mother to have one half the Cleared Land and possession of their own Houses also one Negro Woman named Amy during her life or Widowhood, and after her decease my Will and devise is that the aforesaid Negro shall be Delivered to my well beloved Daughter Anna Burn.

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Item. I also Give to my well beloved Wife Two Fether beds
and Furniture One Young Horse one Old Horse
Three Cows and Calves Three Swine & Hogs one Pater
Dish one Pater Kase one Pater Plate one Iron
Pot one Sying Iron one Case Knives & Forks
Twenty five Kernels Corn one Plough one Stock
One Ox one Hoe one Flax Wheel one Wool Wheel
One Chest one Table one Water Pail one Dutch
Oven one Cuck Stove one Cuck Chimney one half
Cuck Chimney one Case and seven head of sheep
and half the Cotton half the Flax half the Crop of
Wheat now Growing one Mowar saddle and my part
of a skin which is half.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Anna Burn
One whole Possession of Land after my Wifes
decease or Marriage with all other meadow and
Possession of corn land whatever and I do
Constitute make and Ordain Joel Heering &
Frederick Burn my only and sole Executors of
this my last Will and Testament, and I do hereby
attest, Disavow Brooke and disannull all and every
other former Testaments Wills and Legacies bequests
and Executors by me in any way before this time
Made Willed and Bequeathed Ratifying and
Confirming this and no other to be my last Will
(and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal the Day and Year above Written

Item I do Dispose Devise that after my debts
be paid and my Funeral Expenses discharged that
the Residue and Remainder of my Estate be
sold by my two Executors William Lawhorn & Lewis
Whitfield whom I do Appoint and Constitute Executors
to this my last Will and Testament and the Money
 arising therefrom to be Equally Divided Between
my three Children Mary Lawhorn James Parker
and Gilepha Parker In Witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and fixed my seal
This 21. of February 1791
