In the name of God Amen, I Isabel Jernigan of the State of North Carolina in Wayne County, being sick of body and of a sound mind & knowing my mind, make bequest, calling to mind the great frailty of woman's kind, and for the better settling my personal affairs, I make & ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form following. (1st) I Trust & I recommend my soul into the hands of God who give it, and my body to the ground to be buried in a decent manner at the Resurrection & my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. and Touching my worldly Estate which with it has pleased God to bless me with in this life I give & dispose of the same in manner & form following. (That is to say)

First, I give & bequeath to my beloved son & daughter John Wiggs & his wife Alice Wiggs one Shilling & specie. I give & bequeath to my beloved son Joseph Halse & his wife Isabel Hayes one Shilling & specie. Item, I give & bequeath to my beloved son & daughter Etheldred Boyt & his wife Bridgetta Boyt my mare by the name of Pegion, & my saddle & Bridle. Item, I give & bequeath to my beloved son & daughter Jesse Watkins and his wife Catherine Watkins one Shilling & specie. and after my death the remainder & residue of all my goods & Chattels except my old wench Daffy, her children and I am of my

Children which she will, and none of them shall not face her share with them without she is willing to it, and that she shall not be sold nor divided, and the rest I leave to be equally divided between all my sons & daughters that is to say, John Wiggs & his wife Alice Wiggs. Jesse Halse and his wife Isabel Halse. Etheldred Boyt & his wife Bridgetta Boyt. Jesse Watkins & his wife Catherine Watkins. Item Jesse Hayes & Etheldred Boyt whom I likewise constitute make & ordain my sole Executors of this my last will & Testament. and I do hereby utterly revoke and disannul all & every other former Testament, will, Legacies & bequest. & Executors by me in any way before named, wills & bequeathed ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last will & Testament, in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand & seal this 9th January Anno. dom 1783

To all persons to whom these presents shall come or that may be concerned here with. Know ye that I Joseph Cook of Wayne County in North Carolina, being sick of body but of sound mind. do make & ordain this my last will and Testament in the following manner. 1st I give to my son Benjamin Cook four Hundred Acre Land. Lying upon Blue Creek joining Robert Simms & Captain Simms lines to him and his heirs, also a negro Girl named Anna, the other 2^d I give to my son Arthur Cook one piece of Land bounded by the school house branch & the mill pond branch joining Isaac Woodard line upon the other side supposed to be one hundred & twenty five acres to him & his heirs, also one feather bed & furniture his & his heirs and a negro Girl named Patsy and her increase.

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3^d I Give to my son John Cook a piece of Land. bound along to
 head of the mill pond branch, which is a bottom & along to
 Bottom to the back pond. and along the back line to Turn
 Swamp. supposed to be one hundred & fifty Acres to him & his
 heirs. also one negro Girl named Beck she & her increase

4th I Give to my son Stephen Cook the south side of my pla-
 -tation on which I now live. bounded by the little branch
 and the great branch. about two hundred Acres to him & his
 heirs. also one feather bed & furniture. also a negro woman
 named Je & her increase after this date, also two
 cows & calves.

5th I give to my son Jacob Cook the north
 side of my plantation from the little branch. bounded by the
 school house branch and Arthurs line about two hundred
 Acres to him & his heirs. also two cows & calves. also one bed &
 furniture. also one negro Girl named Rose she & her increase

6th I Give to my daughter Helphie Cook. one feather bed and
 furniture also a Negro Girl named Jinna.

7th I Give to
 my daughter Sarah Barner Ten Shillings Sterling

8th I Give to my daughter Mary Hollowell forty Shillings Sterling

9th I Give to my daughter Martha Hollowell Ten Shillings Sterling

10th I Give to my son William Cook Ten Shillings Sterling

11th I Give to my son Thomas Cook Ten Shillings Sterling

12th I Give to Esther Brown one feather bed & furniture

13th I Give to my wife Martha Cook two Negroes named Charles
 and Sall to have the full profit of them during her time not
 to sell or dispose of them any way. and after her death my will
 is that my son Thomas have Charles & my son Benjamin have Sall
 also my will is that my wife have the use & profit of all the remain-
 -ing part of my Estate, which is not above mentioned. Consisting of
 Horses Cattle sheep and household Goods during her life of widow-
 hood and after (decease to be equally divided among my six
 children Benjamin Thomas Arthur Stephen Jacob John and
 Helphie. I appoint my sons Thomas Benjamin Arthur
 John Executors to this my last will & Testament. 24th 7th 1763
