the other part I give & bequeath to my son Caleb Hawley
it being the land my daughter now lives on, & then I give
my mare to my son William, & then I give to my son
Caleb my horse, and if my sons never comes back
from the war, I desire that my Daughter Winny
have one hundred acres land containing my upper im-
provement, and Daughter Dice, to have one hundred acres
land containing the improvement where she now lives, and
Daughter Kille to have one hundred acres land contain-
ing improvement, and my Daughter Winny to have my horse
and my Daughter Dice, to have my mare if my sons never come
I give to my daughter Winny, one Cow half, and to Elizabeth
Hawley one Cow half, and one Cow, and one Cow half I give
my Daughter Dice, and one Cow half I give to my daughter Kille
and know ye that this is my last will & Testament, and I
appoint Jacob Rentfrow and William Hood to be my
Executors
