On the name of God Amen. The 18th January 1782, Richard
Jones of the State of North Carolina & County of Wayne
being weak of body, but of sound & perfect mind & memory
doth be given to god for the same, and calling to mind the
futility of my body, and knowing that it is appointed
to all men Once to die, do make & ordain this instrument
contain my last will & Testament in manner following
In witness, I send to my beloved wife Bereah by the Plan-
tation whereon I now live, being about one hundred &
Ten acres, lying in the fork of Walnut Creek, running
into the Creek to the fork. Then along my prong to the
mouth of the pen branch, then up the branch to the road
near the line of my last Survey. Then with the said
line down to my first Patent line, I also send to my
beloved wife my negro wench Winney, all my Plantation
houses, household goods & stock. During my said wife's widowhood
is no longer. Item I give to my son John Jones one Shilling
sterling besides what I have heretofore given him, his and
his heirs for ever. Item I give to my daughter Willoughby
& Ward one Shilling Sterling money besides what
I have heretofore given her, to her other heirs for ever. Item
I give to my daughter Betty Smith one Shilling Sterling
money besides what I have heretofore given her to her and
her heirs for ever. I give to my daughter Mary Anna Martin
one Shilling Sterling money, besides what I have heretofore given
her to her other heirs for ever. Item I give to my daughter
Frances my negro girl Hannah, and one half of my land
lying on the upper side of the road branch & the stream
and

and the East side of the said Land being my last due
to her and her heirs forever. Item I give to my son Robert
the other half of my land lying on the upperside of the
pond branch, and the swamp and the S. East line of
my east survey, he having his choice of which half
he pleases, and my negro boy George, to him to his heirs
forever, after I give to my son Travers, all the
Land on the East side of the branch that makes out of
the Rooson, lying between walnut Rooson, the
swamps and Martin Johnstones line, being the
Islands Land, including the land whereon Lydia
Jones lives, with this reserve, that my said son
Travers let Lydia Jones live on the place wher
she now livs with about Seventy five Acres and
belonging to said Plantation, till her youngest son Billy
comes to lawfull age, and I give to my said son Travers
my negro boy Sam, to him and his heirs forever, after I give
to my son Coleman all the land lying between the west
side of the said branch, making out of said Rooson and the
said swamp, being Island Land, to him to his heirs forever
Item I give to my son Richard, the land & Plantation as
I left my wife, after her widowhood is determined
to him and his heirs forever, also my will is that if my
widow living as I left to my wife, should have
children, that the first she has my execvce is may
go to my son Coleman, and the next she has to
go to my son Richard, to them & their heirs forever
and my will is that all the estate as I left my
wife at her death or ~~at her death~~ marriage
may,

may be equally divided, amongst all my five
last mentioned children, meaning Franky, Fravida
Robert, Coleman & Richard Jones, to them & their heirs
forever, my will & execvce is if either of my last men-
tioned children shou'd die under age or without
any lawful heir begotten or issued from its own
body, then I desire that the four surviving children
may have ^{the} deceased child part thereof, and so on
if two shou'd die, that the three surviving children
to have the two deceased children's part, and so on
till the last child of my five last mentioned children
if it shou'd so happen, meaning that my estate may go to my
last child or child as it may so happen to his, her or their
heirs forever, and my execvce is that Lydia Jones may keep the
cattle where she livs, till her youngest son Billy Jones come
to lawfull age, and then to be equally divided between her
two sons Frederick, and said Billy Jones, to them & their heirs
forever, and lastly I constitute nominate & appoint my
friend John Roberts and my loving wife Ursula Jones
Executor & Executrix of this my last will & Testament
determining, revoking and making void all other
Wills and Testaments by me made, Ratifying and
Confirming this and no other to be my last will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal the day & year first above
written
