Item I give unto the heirs of my daughter Mary Diphin deceased one English Shilling & no more

Item, I give unto my beloved wife one negroe wench named Millie during her life, and after her decease to my daughter Bitha, and my will is that my wife keep my negroes while my children, namely Bitha and Sally come to the age of eighteen years, except my wife should marry - Item I give unto my wife all my stock of every kind and my household goods of all sorts whatsoever, and further more I do appoint and constitute Andrew Bagg Dod. and my wife my executor of this my last will and Testament (disannulling all and every other will or will herebefore made by me in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 0th day of March 1786
