Returns of To April Court 1703 / 30

In the name of God Amen I John Tilton of wayne County  
of Carolina being sick of body & weak. tho. of sound  
mind and perfect memory Thanks be to Omnipotent God for it  
and falling to mind the mortality of my body That all men  
has one to die. So make constitute & ordain this my last  
will & Testament in manner & form following, first I  
Commit my soul to him that give it me. and my body to the  
ground to be buried by my Executors hereafter named, and as to  
what worldly goods it hath pleased to bless me with. I Give  
and Bequeath as followeth; First I would that all my  
debts be paid by my Executors.

Item I Give & lend to my beloved wife Elizabeth Tilton during  
life or widowhood my plantation with the Improvements  
and two hundred acres with it lying on this side of the branch  
below against Kabove next Ballards and Scotts lines at  
her death time to belong to my son Wm Tilton, and also to my wife  
I Give one bed & furniture. six Dutch plates. one Boxon large  
two small dishes so as to in the whole contain one third of the  
Dinner, and also one third of all my kitchen furniture of  
the Cattle one third Equally divided, one riding best horse  
or mare fit for use, also my provision for support present  
with also my stock of Horn great & small & after her departure  
if these things may be equally divided amongst all  
my children save the Cattle, none of them to Hannah  
Tilton she having had her part. Item I Give working Tools  
to my son John Tilton such as Carpenters Tools,  
Item I Give & Bequeath to my children not yet named my  
land the whole and all the remainder of my land to be  
equally divided among the other five, John, Hannah, Elizabeth,  
Samuel, Colley & Leonard. to be divided by lot.  
It the remainder of my Cattle to be divided by lot among  
the same five children. As to the remainder of my debts  
I Give to be Equally divided among all my children

And Casly I do make constitute & ordain my  
 whole sole Executor & Executors my beloved wife  
 Elizabeth Tilton, Hannah Tilton, Elizabeth Tilton  
 my Daughters, John Howell, and I do hereby revoke all  
 former wills by me made, and do ratify & confirm this  
 my last will & Testament, and desire it may be received  
 as such, in witness whereof I have here unto set my hand  
 and face my seal this 20<sup>th</sup> March 1753

 State of N. Carolina in Wayne County, being sick & weak  
 of a sound mind & knowing my own mind & being  
 to mind the great mortality of woman kind, and for the better  
 settling my Temporal affairs, I make & ordain this my last will  
 and Testament in manner & form following. (1<sup>st</sup>) First  
 I recommend my soul into the hands of God who give it, and  
 my body to the ground to be buried in a decent manner at the  
 Resurrection of my Executors nothing doubting but at the former  
 Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power  
 of God, and Touching my worldly Estate where with it hath  
 pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give & dispose of  
 same in manner & form following. (That is to say)  
 I give & bequeath to my beloved son & daughter  
 John Wiggs & his wife Alice Wiggs one shilling & six pence  
 I give & bequeath to my beloved son Joseph Wigg & his wife  
 Isabel Wigg one shilling & six pence. Item, I give & bequeath  
 to my beloved son & daughter Etheldred Boy & his wife Brice  
 Boy & my mare by the name of Pegion, & my saddle & Bridle  
 Item I give & bequeath to my beloved son & daughter Jesse Wigg  
 and his wife Catherine Wiggins one shilling & six pence and  
 my death the remainder & residue of all my goods & Chattels  
 Except my old wench Dafing, her to live with my of
