all my children

my Will in Witness whereof I Have unto Set my
Hand and Affixed my Seal this Day and
Turnover

my Tanner plantation During her life or
widowhood Contain two Hundred & five Acres of
land and that James Jones & his Heirs shall Remain on
the same plantation or Molsted and after her
Death or Marriage I give the said Tanner plantati-
on and land the Acres above Mentioned to my
son James Jones to him and his Heirs for ever
I also Give my Beloved Wife Sarah Jones My House
and

House Hold Furniture and after her Death
or Marriage for the said furniture to be Divided
that James Jones have the One Half of the same
and the other Half to Sarah Jones my Daughter
to them and there for ever
I also Give my Beloved Wife Sarah Jones my
riding Horse and saddle & bridle During her life
or widowhood the said Horse & saddle & bridle after
her Death or Marriage I give to my Daughter Sarah
Jones to her & her Heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Honour
Jones One Linnen wheel & five shilling Current
Money to her & her Heirs for ever -

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter ^{her} ~~James~~
Powell five shillings Current Money to her & her Heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my son Hardy Jones five
shillings Current Money to him and his Heirs for ever

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter Grace
Star Five shillings Current money to her & her Heirs for ever

shillings Current money to him and his Heirs for ever
