In the Name of God Amen the 10th Day,
October in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven
Hundred and Ninety Two, I John Anderson of the
State of North Carolina and County of Wayne being
Wick of Body but of sound and perfect mind and
Memory, and Calling to mind the Mortality of my
Body, and knowing that it is appointed for all
Men once to die. Do make and ordain this Instru-
ment to contain my last Will and Testament in manner
Following; that is to say (Principally and first of
all, I give and Recommend my Soul into the
hands of Almighty God that gave it me, and my
Body to the Earth, to be Buried in a Christian
like, and Decent manner at the Discretion of my
Executors hereafter named; and as Touching such
worldly Estate as it hath been pleased God to
Bestow me with in this Life, I give devise and
dispose of in manner following (To Wit) I Impart
I lend to my beloved Wife my Lands and Plantation
of one Hundred and Sixty five Acres whereon I now
live during her natural life, and after my Wifes de-
cease I give my Lands and Plantations as I lent her
to my son Jesse Anderson and what other things I give
him at his marriage to him and his heirs forever
I then I give to my son Thomas Anderson One Mil-
ling Sterling Money besides what I have heretofore
given him at his marriage to him and his heirs for-
ever.

Item. I give to my son Wiley Anderson one
Spilling & Tasting Honey besides what I have
before given him at his Marriage to him and
his heirs forever - Item. I give to my Daughter
Fanny Smith one Cow and Calf besides what
I have before given her at her Marriage, to her
and her heirs forever - Item. I give to my
daughter Betty Smith one Horse, Buggy and
Furniture, and one Cow and Calf to her and
her heirs forever. Likewise all the Rest of my
Estate as I have not heretofore mentioned, I give
to my said Wife to her and her own heirs forever,
and lastly I constitute nominate
and appoint my Friend Barnaby W. Kinno and
my beloved wife Exeutors and Executors of this my
last Will and Testament. Ratifying and Con-
firming the same no other to be my last Will &
Testament. Disannulling and making void all
other Wills and Testaments by me made In
Witness whereof I the said John Anderson have
hereunto set my hand and affixt my Seal this
Day and Year first within Written
