One Negro boy by the name of Charles and Fifty pounds
Species and all other property which I have Given him
from time to time

Item that I Give to my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Earl
one negro boy by the name of Eph and Forty pounds
Species and all other property which I have Given her
from time to time

Item that I Give to my beloved Daughter Lighty
Annons one negro woman by the name of Tam
and her Spinners and also one negro Girl by the name
of Amy and all other property which I have Given her
from time to time

Item that I Give to my Grand Daughter Edith Thompson
Jernigan Twenty pounds Species one Feather Bed
and Furniture and one Cow and Calf

Item that I Give to my Beloved Son Silas Jernigan
Three hundred Acres of Land Containing the Plantation
whereon I now live which is the manner Plantation
and three Negroes By the name of Charles Connor
and Hanner with all the Horses Cattle dogs and
Stock of Every kind after the sum of Ninety pounds
Species being made by my executors to pay up the

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Two Legacies of Charity Thompson and Elizabeth
Bate out of the said Stocks and also all my house
hold Furniture and working Tools and also Two
lots in the Town of Waverlyborough

And I Here Make and Ordain Josiah Jernigan
and Silas Jernigan My Executors of this my last
will and Testament and I do utterly disallow
Revoke and Disannul all and Every other former
Testaments wills Legacies and bequeaths by me in
any ways before wills bequeaths or Satisfyed
and Confirm this and no other to be my last will
and Testament in writing which of I have hereunto
Set my Hand and affixed my Seal this 7th of
August 1795 (Signed)

In the Name of God Amen the 15th day
of October 1795 I Frederick Jordan of Wayne County
and State of North Carolina being sick and weak
of body but of perfect mind and Memory thanks be
to God for the same Calling mind the Mortality
of my body and knowing that it is appointed for
all men Once to die do make and ordain this In
testament to contain my last will and Testament
in Manner to wit

I Give my Son Aaron Jordan my Negro boy Tim
that he now has in his possession and what other
things I gave him at his Marriage (Turn over)

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To him and his heirs for Ever - I then I give to my Daughter Pinyor Lane my Negro woman banner that she now has in possession and her Inheritance During her Natural Life and after her Death my desire is that the wench & her Inheritance should be Equally divided betwixt all her Children and also the other things that I let her have at her Marriage I give to her and heirs for Ever - I then I give to my Daughter Panny Smith forty acres of Land as I patented myself joining the Land she now lives on and the Negro boy Jacob and what other things I let her have at her marriage to her and heirs for Ever - I then I give to my Daughter Pincy Hamm the Girl basket and what other things I let her have at her Marriage to her and her heirs for Ever - I then I give to my Son Frederick Jordan one horse bridle and saddle one Feather Bed and Furniture two cows and Calves that I let him have at his Marriage to him and his for Ever - I then I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Holmes my Negro Girl Grace and one Feather bed and Furniture to her and her heirs for Ever - I then I give to my son Nathaniel Jordan my three Negro boys Coker little Harry and Hampton and the horse that is called his and one bridle and saddle to him and his heirs for Ever - I then I give to my Daughter Clarkey Jordan my Negro Girl Jane one Feather Bed and Furniture at her coming to lawful age or Marriage to her and her heirs for Ever - I then I give to my Daughter Vincy Jordan my negroe Girl little Liza one Feather Bed and Furniture at her coming

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to lawful age or Marriage to her and her heirs
 for ever — Item I give to my son Charles Jordan
 one Negro boy Named Lewis to him and her heirs
 for ever — Item I give to my Daughter Amy
 Jordan my Negro Girl Sarah one feather bed
 and furniture as her coming to lawful age or
 Marriage to her and her heirs for ever — Item
 My will and desire is that what money is due
 me should go to pay my Lawful (Debts and if
 there should be any my desire is that my
 Executors should sell such things as they think
 proper to settle my Debts and my desire is that
 My Children that is in their nonage should live
 together on my Plantation until they arrive to law-
 ful age or Marriage and for my wife to keep them
 to school and Raise them and if my wife should die
 before My Daughter Amy comes to twelve years
 of age then for my Executors to Continue the liv-
 ing as I shall hereafter find my wife and the Chil-
 dren living such as be under age at her Death un-
 till my Amy comes to twelve years of age all
 to be Continued on my Plantation until the above
 mentioned time also all the rest of my Estate as
 I have Not already Mentioned such as Lands Negroes
 household furniture Stock &c — I find to my better
 wife Winiford during her Widowhood and if she
 should marry my Desire is that Jack and Bob
 and Tom should be sold by my Executors and
 Twenty five pounds a piece should be given to my
 five youngest Daughters meaning Dory, Harman

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 Elizabeth Clarky Guey and Amey Jordan and the rest
 of the Money to be divided amongst all my Daughters
 and Amey Jordan and Frederick Jordan and the rest
 of the living which I leave by wife for her to have
 it during her Natural life with this Reserve she
 allowing my son Charles to have two hundred acres
 of land at the lower part of my plantation next
 to the Creek if he should want it to settle before
 my wife should die and after my wifes death I give
 all my land as I lent her to my son Charles Jordan
 to him and his heirs forever and likewise after my wifes
 death my Desire is that if any of the negroes should
 die that I have given to any Unmarried Daughters
 upon they come to lawful age or Marriage that
 their Negroes should be made good out of the Estate
 that my wife then my Desire is the rest of my estate
 that I have by wife should be sold the money
 Equally Divided betwixt all my Daughters
 and my son Amey Jordan and Frederick Jordan.
 Equally to Harry and old Ann and my Desire is
 that they should choose their Master to serve
 who they please so it be one of my Children and
 the part that falls to my Daughter Mary Lane my
 Desire is that she should have it her life time and
 at her Death to be equally divided betwixt all her
 Children and if any of my Daughters should die without
 heir my desire is that their Legacy should be equally
 divided betwixt those that should remain alive and
 lastly I constitute nominate & appoint loving Friend
 John Spann Frederick Jordan andustus Hamm Executors
 of this my last will & Testament disannulling all other wills
 by me made in Witness I the said Frederick Jordan have
 set my hand and fixed my seal the day and date of
 this year above written -

In the Name of God Amen the Twenty eighth
 day of September one thousand seven hundred and
 eighty nine, I Benjamin Walling of Magaw coun-
 ty in the State of North North Carolina Being of
 perfect mind and Memory thanks be given unto
 God; therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of
 my Body and Knowing that it is Appointed for
 all men Once to die, Do make and ordain this my
 last Will and Testament that is to say principally
 and first of all I Give and Recommend my Soul
 into the Hands of God that gave it and for my
 Body I Recommend it to the Earth to be buried in
 a Christian like and Decent manner at the discre-
 tion of my Executors hereafter Named Nothing
 Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
 Receive this same again by the Mighty Power of
 God; and as Touching such Worldly Estate where
 with it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this
 life, I Give (Revises and dispose of the same in the
 following Manner and form -

Imprimis I Give and bequeath unto my son Samuel
 Walling all my Land plantations with all the Impro-
 vements after the Decease of my beloved wife Sarah
 Walling to him and his heirs forever, Also I Give to my son
 Samuel Walling all my Carpenters and Joiners Tools -
