one Thousand Seven hundred and Ninety five
I Jacob Lamb of wayne County being sick
in body but of good and sound Memory
thank be to god and calling to Remembrance
the uncertain Estate of this Transitory life
and that all Flesh must yield to death
when it shall please to god to call for
me I make constitute ordain and Delcare this
my Last will & Testament in writing
form following Revoking and annulling
by three presents all and every Testament
or Testaments will & wills heretofore by me
made and Declared Either by word or writ
ing and this is to be taken only for my
Last will and Testament and none other
and first I give my soul to god that give
it and body to be buried in such a place
where it shall please my Executors
hereafter named to appoint and now for the
settling of my Temporal Estate I give
and bequeath unto Hardy Watson sum of
Seven Acres of Land more or less lying on the
South Side of black creek containing the
plantation whereon the said Hardy Watson
now Lives, I give unto my son Isaac
Lamb one hundred Acres of Land lying on
the North Side of the Long Branch it

it, being part of that Tract of Land that
Abraham Lamb now lives on, I then, I give
unto Reddick Lamb after my decease
Twenty five Acres of Land Lying on the
South Side of Black Creek, I then I give unto
my Son David Lamb the plantation whereon

plantation containing four hundred and
Twenty Eight Acres with one Mill one
Still one Rifle Gun &c, I desire that all
my Sons may have Liberty of Using the
Still that I left to David as long as they
stay in this Settlement, I then, I give unto my Grand
Son John Lamb Two Cows and calves, I then, I give
unto my Grand Daughter Phoebe Lamb Two
Cows and Calves, I then, I give unto my Grand
Daughter Sary Two Cows and calves,
I then, I give unto my Grand Daughter Lethy

Watson Eight pounds Virginia money and
one pair Spoon Molds and one pair plate
Molds, I then, I give unto David Lamb
one bed & furniture and one pot and two
head of sheep and one Tea kettle and one
chest and Trunk and one Case of bottles
I then, I give unto John Lamb one bed & furniture
I then, I give unto Rodah Watson one Trunk
I then, I give unto Sarah Luker one Trunk
I then, I give unto David Lamb one Spade
three plaining Irons,
