 of the County of Wayne and State of North Carolina

 and bringing to mind the uncertainty of this Life, and
 that it is appointed unto all Men Once to Die, do make
 and constitute this my last Will and Testament
 in manner and form following (that is to say) This
 and Principally of all, I give and bequeath my Soul in
 into the hands of God who gave it me and my Body
 I Recommend to the Earth to be Decently Buried as
 at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter to me
 mentioned and as for my worldly Goods, with which it
 hath pleased Almighty God to bless me with, I give and
 bequeath in manner and form following (To Wit)
 Item. My Will and Desire is that so much of the Perish-
 part of my Estate be sold by my Executors, and not by the
 Sheriff, as will pay my Debts

Item. My Will and Desire is that all my Lands where
 I have not Deeded a way heretofore be Equally divided
 between my Son (To Wit) Robert and Joshua. Except
 so much adjoining my Mansion House as shall be
 sufficient to maintain my Wife Christian her
 Life time, which Lands I give to the Aforesaid Edward
 Robert and Joshua to them and their Heirs for ever -

 Item. My Will and Desire furthering that
 all my Personal Estate, be Equally divided
 between my Wife Christian Musgrave, my sons
 (To Wit) Thomas Musgrave, Edward Musgrave
 Robert Musgrave and Joshua
 Musgrave, and my daughter Elizabeth Musgrave
 and Sally Musgrave. Which said Personal
 Property I give to the aforesaid Christian Mus-
 grave, Thomas Musgrave, Edward Musgrave
 Robert Musgrave, Joshua
 Musgrave, Elizabeth Musgrave, and Sally
 Musgrave, to them and their Heirs for ever.
 And I do hereby Nominate, Constitute, and ap-
 point Uriah Ruff, and my Beloved Son Thomas
 Musgrave Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament Revoking and Disallowing all and
 every other Will, or Wills or Testaments by me
 hitherto made. Ratifying and confirming this
 to be my last Will and Testament, In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 this Day and Year above Written
