 that I leave to my wife should be sold the money
 Equally Divided between all my Daughters
 and my son Leon Jordan and Frederick Jordan
 Equally old Harry and old Ann and my Desire is
 that they should choose their Master to serve
 who they please so it be one of my Children and
 the part that falls to my Daughter prior Lane my
 Desire is that she should have it her Life time and
 at her Death to be equally divided betwixt all her
 Children and if any of my Daughters should die without
 heir my desire is that their Legacy should be equally
 divided betwixt those that should remain alive and
 lastly I do hereby nominate & appoint loving Friend
 John Spann Frederick Jordan andustus Hamm Exors.
 of this my last will & Testament disannulling all other wills
 by me made in Writing I the said Frederick Jordan have
 with my hand and fixed my seal the day and date of

 day of September one thousand seven hundred and
 eighty nine I Benjamin Walsing of Wagsaw coun-
 ty in the State of North Carolina Being of
 perfect mind and Memory thanks be given unto
 God; therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of
 my Body and Knowing that it is appointed for
 all men Once to die, Do make and ordain this my
 last Will and Testament that is to say principally
 and first of all I Give and Recommend my Soul
 into the Hands of God that gave it and for my
 Body I Recommend it to the earth to be buried in
 a Christian like and Decent manner at the discre-
 tion of my Executors hereafter named Nothing
 doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
 Receive the same again by the Mighty Power of
 God; and as Touching such Worldly Estate where
 with it hath pleased God to Bless me with in this
 life, I Give Devise and dispose of the same in the
 following Manner and form -

I hereby Give and bequeath unto my son Samuel
 Walsing all my Land plantations with all the Impro-
 vements after the Decease of my Beloved wife Sarah
 Walsing to him and his heirs for ever, Also I give to my son
 Samuel Walsing all my Carpenters and Joiners Tools -

Item, I have the Land and plantation wherein I now
 dwell unto my Beloved Wife Sarah Walsing for the
 Term of her Natural Life as also I have to my said
 wife the use of all my Personal or Moveable Estate
 During of her Life, and after her Death to be Equally
 Divided among my Children Samuel Walsing
 Elender Walsing, Saline Walsing and not to be sold
 after my Death but to be Equally Divided between
 them three Item I give ~~to my wife~~ and bequeath
 unto my well beloved Son in Law Edmund Gird
 an ~~and~~ to his wife five Shillings of Silver
 Item I give to my well beloved Son in Law Elias
 Grantham and Mary his wife five Shillings of Silver
 Also I constitute and appoint my Beloved wife Sarah
 Walsing Executors and my Son Samuel Walsing Executors
 and John Oliver of Johnston County Executors of this my
 Last will and Testament and do hereby Utterly Disallow
 Resallow and Revoke all and Every other Wills and Legacies
 Bequeaths and Executors by me bequeathed (ratifying) and
 confirming this and no other to be my Last will and Tes-
 tament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my Seal the day and year first above written
 Signed Sealed Published and Pronounced by the said Benjamin
 Walsing, to be his Last will and Testament
