John Greer to Sophia Greer bill of Sale February Term 1797

Know all men by these presents that I John Greer of Melhus County and State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Spanish milled dollars to me in hand paid by Sophia Greer the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the said Sophia Greer a negro boy named Charles to have and to hold the said bargained premises unto the said Sophia Greer her heirs and assigns forever. And I the said John Greer in myself my heirs Executors and Administrators shall and will warrant and defend against all persons by these presents

James Wallaw to Annanias Allen Power of Attorney

Know all men by these presents that I James Wallaw of the State of North Carolina and County of Melhus as constable and agent my trusty friend Annanias Allen my true and lawful Attorney for me and on my name and seal in full power and legal authority to make a lease for feed to a tract or parcel of land lying in Melhus County on the River of Kings Creek containing one hundred acres beginning in Thomas Cox's line thence East with John Wallaw to a stake thence North to corner of a certain section thence West to a pond thence to the first station the said deed to be made agreeable to the original and conveyed to John Melch of said State and County and the said Allen is not hereby bound to stand culpable to said Melch in case said land should be taken by any other claims but is hereby authorized to assign a deed of conveyance to said Melch as soon as may be possible from the original in James Wallaw's name for said land but said Wallaw shall stand culpable in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th of September 1795
