Know all men by these presents that we Patrick Hamrick and Carlton Huston John Gibbalt have held and firmly bound unto Richard B. Spaight Esq. Governor of said State in the first and full term of our hundredth session a sum to be paid to the said R. B. Spaight Esq. Governor and his successors or assigns to which payment we will and truly to be made and our heirs our executors Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and Dated the 28th Day of November Anno Domini 1794

The condition of the above obligation. Such that if the above bound Patrick Hamrick Administrator of the Estate of the said deceased John Gibbalt do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods and Chattels rights and credits of the Deceased which have or shall come into the hands knowledge or possession of any other person or persons for him and the same to make a true bill or cause to be exhibited into the Secretary's office and one attested copy thereof to the County Court of the County where the said Deceased died to be paid within forty days after the Date of these presents and the same goods Chattels and Credits and all other goods Chattels and Credits of the Deceased at the time of Death which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession of the said Patrick Hamrick or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory according to law and further to make a true and perfect Inventory of his said Administration within one year after the date of these presents And that and that the said goods and Chattels and Credits which shall be found remaining upon the said Administration account General or County Court shall Deliver or pay to such person or persons and meaning of Act in that case made and provided and if it shall appear that any will or testimony was made by the deceased and the same is equal to have it allowed and approved of according to the said Act then such other bounden being thereunto required do render and deliver the letters of Administration approbation of such the same thing and of no effect otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue
