Hendon and William A. Clain are and from by Bond unto the
next next Governor of the State in the full view of free and open
proclamation money to be paid to said John Denman by Governor
his Successors or Assigns to the which payment we and truly to be made
we bind ourselves our heirs by Administration jointly and severally
firmly by these presents sealed with our seal and dated the seven
Day of March anno Domini 1781

The Condition of this Obligation is such that if the above signed
Elizabeth Roberts Administration of all and singular the Goods and
 Chattels Rights and Credits of John Roberts deceased at the time
of his decease to be and shall come to the hands or possession of the said
Elizabeth Roberts or into the hands or possession of any person
or persons for her and the same so made do Exhibit or cause to
be exhibited into the Secretarys office and one true Copy
hereof to the County Court where Order for Administration
passed within ninety Days after the Date of these presents
and the same Goods and Chattels and Credits and all other
Goods Chattels and Credits of the Deceased at time of his decease
which at any time hereafter shall come into the hands or possession
of the said Elizabeth Roberts or into the hands or possession of any
Other person or persons for her do well and truly Administer ac-
cording to Law and further do make or cause to be made a true
and full Account of her said Administration within one year
After the Date of these presents and all the Profit and Proceeds
of the said Goods and Chattels and Credits which shall be found
Remaining upon the said Administration account the same
being first Examined and Allowed by the Governor and Council
General Court or County Court shall deliver and pay unto
Each person or persons respectively as the same shall be due
pursuant to the True Intent and meaning of the act in that
Case made and provided and if it shall appear that any will
or Testament was made by the Deceased and executed or executed
therein named do Exhibit the same into Court making Request
to have it Allowed and approved of accordingly if the said Elizabeth
Roberts above Bounden being the same Requested do Bonds
and deliver the said Letters of Administration approbation of
such Testament being first had and made in the said Court
this Obligation to be void and of no Effect or Else to Remain in
full force and Virtue
