Last Will and Testament of Emanuel Rose Deceased by Test

In the Name of our Saviour I Emanuel Rose of Wilkes County and North Carolina being in perfect mind and memory but some what afflicted in body. Calling to mind the Mortality of man and that it was appointed once for all to die. I make and name this my last will and Testament first of all I recommend my soul to God that gave it and my body to the Earth to be Buried in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but I shall receive it again at the last Resurrection by the almighty power of God

And in teaching this worldly Estate which it has pleased God to bless me with I give, devise and dispose of in the following manner and I give to wit first I leave to my beloved wife Mary Rose my whole Estate during her natural life or widow hood and after her decease or Marriage the whole to be equally divided between my five Beloved Children to wit Maria Rose Mary Fells way Mary Rose Elizabeth Rose Susanna Rose in the first place before it is divided each one of them that is single at this time is to have as much as Mary who is Married to wit one good house & want one good bed and furniture one Cow one Horse & five or six V Cows and after each of them the above mentioned Children has two as much as Mary then the Balance to be equally divided between the whole five children in which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 28 day of August 1796
