Know all men by these Presents that we Francis Hardgrave the

Evans & Richard Allen Esq^rs of the County of Wilkes and
State of North Carolina are held and firmly bound unto
Richard D. Maugh Esq^r our Governor of the said State in the
full and just sum of one thousand pounds Current Money
of said State to be paid to him the said Rich D. Maugh Esq^r
and his successors to which payment well and truly to be
made we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators

strictly and firmly by these presents
Sealed with our seals and dated this 6th Day of August AD 1795

The condition of the above obligation is such that

Whereas the above bound Francis Hardgrave hath been
appointed Governor of the County of Wilkes by the County
Court now if the said Francis Hardgrave shall well
and truly execute and discharge his said office as Governor
and according to Law then the above obligation to be void
Otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
