Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Cole of the County of Wilkes and State of North Carolina have constituted and appointed Job Cole of the County and State aforesaid my true and lawful Attorney for me and in my name to transact all things respecting my lands in the District West of the mountains together with all rents due and demand at his pleasure to lease and release the said lands together with all the appurtenances thereto to belong by me as fee and ample a manner as I might or could do were I personally present.
