 presents sealed with our seals and Dated this 27 Day of
 October A.D. 1787

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that when
 the above named William Roushau hath this Day been
 appointed Governor of the County of North Carolina by the
 County Court now of the said William Roushau shall
 not and truly execute and discharge his said Office
 as Governor and according to Law then the above Obligation
 to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
