

Know all men by these presents that I David Witherpoon of the State of North Carolina and the County of Wilkes have the day hereunder sold & delivered unto Chapman Gordon of the said State & County one negro woman named Hannah and twenty three years of age and her child named Nelly about six or seven months of age for the sum of ninety five pounds six shillings and eight pence to me in hand paid which sum I acknowledge to be fully paid with me by these presents warrant and you ever expect the said property of said Negro Slaves named Hannah and Nelly with all the furniture increase unto the said Chapman Gordon his heirs and assigns for ever against me the said David Witherpoon my heirs and assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever In testimony whereof I have settoe at my hand and seal this first day of May one thousand seven hundred and ninety five Wilkes my hand

Know all Men by these Presents that James Brown of the State of Georgia for sundry good causes now thenunto moving so to do and constitute my Trusty Friend Robert Shiffard with full Power and authority to make over and convey unto John Tonister his heirs or assigns one Tract of Land of 200 acres & one Tract of one hundred acres Whence Tilling Tonister & Benjamin Thomas now live in my name and in as ample a manner as if it was then present by all Intents and Purposes as if signed by myself in Wilkes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth Day of February 1792
