Know all men by these presents that I David Witherspoon of the State of North Carolina and the County of Wilkes hath this Day bargained sold & delivered unto Chapman Gordon of the said State & County one negro woman named Hannah and twenty three years of Age and her child named Stephen about six or seven Months of Age for the sum of ninety three pounds six shillings and eight pence to me in hand paid which sum I acknowledge to be fully paid with & so by these presents warrant and for ever defend the said property of said Negro Slaves named Hannah and Stephen with all the fixtures increase unto the said Chapman Gordon his heirs and Assigns for ever against me the said David Witherspoon my heirs and Assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh Day of May one thousand seven hundred and ninety five Wilkes my hand
