Know all Persons whom it may concern That I Christopher Monday of Wilkes County in the State of North Carolina for and in Consideration of the sum of seventeen pounds Three Shillings and six pence lawful Money of North Carolina to me in hand paid by Isaac Harrel of the same County and State aforesaid the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have Bargained and sold in plain & open Market one certain tract of land containing One Hundred and forty Eight Acres of land lying and being in the County of Wilkes in the State aforesaid joining William Mitchell on Pipecamp Creek wherein the said Christopher Monday now lives and perhaps together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any ways appertaining to the said Described tract of land I the said Christopher Monday do warrant and assign from me my Heirs Executors and Administrators and Assignees forever notwithstanding One Black mare that was Under Execution at the Suit of William Mitchell I do Warrant and Assign her on the same consideration as the said Land was sold Never the less be it provided that if the said Christopher Monday doth for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators or Assignee pay unto the said Isaac Harrel his Heirs & executors Administrators or Assignees the sum of full sum of Seventeen pounds four Shillings and six pence at or upon the 29th day of April in the year of our Lord 1794 that then above said Mortgage Bill of Sale to be void or else remain in full force and Virtue given under my hand and Seal this 29th day of April 1795 —

16 J. Robnett { Bill of Sale for Negro girl -
Chapman Gordon May Term 1795

Know all men by these presents that I J. Robnett of the State of North Carolina and the County of Wilkes hath this Day bargained sold and Delivered unto Chapman Gordon of the said State & County one certain Negro Girl named Dilley about the age of twelve Years old for the sum of Eighty five pounds to me in hand paid which sum I acknowledge to be fully satisfied with her by this present warrant and for ever will assign the property of said Negro Slave named Dilley with her further increase unto the said Chapman Gordon his Heirs and Assigns for ever against me my heirs and Assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever no testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this first day August one thousand seven hundred and ninety four witness my Hand J. Robnett Interred before Spring
