Know all Persons whom it may concern That I Christopher Munday of Wilkes County in the State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and Ten Shillings and Six pence Lawful Money of North Carolina to me in hand paid by Isaac Harvil of the same County the State aforesaid the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and delivered unto Isaac Harvil one certain Tract or parcel of Land containing One Hundred and Forty Eight Acres of Land lying and being in the County of Wilkes in the State aforesaid joining William Nelson on the West and Joseph Campbell on the East and Christopher Munday now lives and possesses together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging even in any ways appertaining to the said Described Tract of Land I the said Christopher Munday do warrant and assign from me my heirs Executors and Administrators and Assigns forever And likewise One Black mare that was under execution of the writ of William Mitchell I do warrant and defend on in the same consideration as the said Land was sold Thus the life be it known that if the said Christopher Munday doth for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators or Assigns say unto the said Isaac Harvil his heirs Executors Administrators or Assigns the sum and full sum of Seven hundred and Ten Shillings and Six pence at or upon the 29 day of April in the year of our Lord 1794 That then above said Mortgage Bill of Sale to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue given under my hand and seal this 29th day of April 1793

May Term 1795

Know all men by these presents that Jesse Robinson of the State of North Carolina and the County of Wilkes hath this Day bargained sold and delivered unto Chapman Gordon of the said State & County one certain Negro Girl named Dilly about the age of twelve Years old for the sum of Eighty five pounds to me in hand paid which sum I acknowledge to be fully satisfied with and by these presents warrant and for ever defend the property of said Negro Slave named Dilly with her future increase unto the said Chapman Gordon his heirs and Assigns for ever against me my heirs and Assigns or any other person or persons whatsoever in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this first Day August one thousand seven hundred and ninety four Witness my hand Jesse Robinson Seal
