These all men by these presents that we John Bagby and John Martin all of Wilkes County in the State of North Carolina are full and freely Bound unto Benjamin Thompson Esq. and the rest of the Justices of the County of Wilkes of this and Quarter Sessions for the County of Wilkes in the sum of Two Hundred pounds Current Money to be paid to the said Justice or the Survivors or Successors their Executors or Administrators in Trust for the Benefit of the Child hereafter Named Committed to the Trust of the said John Bagby To the which payment we are and truly to be made we bind Ourselves and each of us each and every of Our Heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents sealed with Our Seals and Dated this 6th Day of February 1793

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the above Bounden John Bagby is Committed and appointed Guardian to John Martin a Minor Defendant of the said John Bagby Shall faithfully execute his said Guardianship by Administering and Improving the Estate of the said John Martin that shall come unto his Possession for the Benefit of the said John Martin until he shall arrive at full age or otherwise there to Request and then Render a plain and true Account of his said Guardianship on Oath before the Justices of the said County Court & Deliver up and pay to or for the said John Martin of all such Estate or Estates as he ought to be possessed of or to such other persons as shall be Lawfully Impowered or Authorized to Receive the same and the Profits arising therefrom Then this Obligation to be void Otherwise to be and Remain in full Force and Virtue
