

North Carolina This Indenture made the 30th of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine Between William Lewis Esq^r Chairman of the County Court of Wilkes in behalf of the Justices of the said County and their Successors in Office of the one part and John Jennings of said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Lewis Esq^r in pursuance to an order of Court and according to an Act of Assembly in such case made and provided, doth put place and bind unto the said John Jennings two negro boys named William Adkins and James Adkins and one girl named Anna Adkins to learn the occupation of Farming and a Spicetop with the said John Jennings to live after the manner of apprentices and servants until the said Apprentices boys shall attain to the age of twenty one years and the girl to eighteen, during all which time the said apprentices their masters shall faithfully serve his lawful commands every where they shall be, shall not at any times absent themselves from their said masters service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful servant shall behave towards their said Masters and the said John Jennings doth covenant promise and agree to and with the said William Lewis Esq^r that he will conveniently provide his house sufficient diet washing and lodging fitting for an apprentice and the same aforesaid; also all other things necessary both in sickness and in health and to learn the said apprentices to read and write. State of North Carolina This Indenture made the 2nd of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine Between William Lewis Esq^r Chairman of the County Court of Wilkes and State aforesaid on behalf of the Justices of the said County and their Successors of the one part and Elisha Jennings of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Lewis Esq^r in pursuance to an order of the County Court and the 2nd of May 1799 and according to an Act of Assembly in that case made and provided doth put place and bind unto the said Elisha Jennings an orphan boy named John Adkins aged eleven years the 2nd of January last to learn the occupation of a farmer with the said Elisha to live after the manner of an apprentice and servant until the said apprentice shall attain to the age of twenty one years during all which time the said apprentice his master shall faithfully serve his lawful commands every where they shall be, shall not at any times absent himself from his said Masters service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful servant shall behave towards his said Master and the said Elisha doth covenant promise and agree to and with the said William Lewis Esq^r that he the said Elisha will and doth provide for the said apprentice during this term aforesaid sufficient diet washing and lodging fitting for an apprentice also all other things necessary both in sickness and in health, and to learn the said apprentice to read and write and to cipher as far as the rules of this act require him a tolerable person with the unless whereof the parties have interchangeably set their hands and seals the day and year first above written
