Know all persons whom it may concern That Leonard Theling of the State of North Carolina and Wilkes County for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds of good and lawful money to me in hand paid by Archibald Lovelace of the County and State aforesaid the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have Bargained sold and Delivered and by these presents according to the due Form of Law do Bargain sell and Deliver unto the said Archibald Lovelace four certain Horse brasts, white head of Cattle, twenty head of Hogs, four feather Peas and furniture, three Boards two butter Dishes, seven pewter plates one pewter Platter one Chest two saddles four pails four horse shoe axes, a certain parcel of Carpenter tools, two Hattocks three pots, one Dutch oven three spinning wheels, one tin Cup, one Coffee pot, one Looking Glass, four Bakers one Saw one cutting knife and Box, one with one still, three Bells, one flat Iron, to have and to hold till the said Bargained Premises unto the said Archibald Lovelace his Executors Administrators and assigns forever and I the said Leonard Theling for myself my Executors and Administrators the said Bargained Premises unto the said Archibald Lovelace his Executors administrators and assigns against all Persons, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents the said Archibald from any Person or persons from laying any Claim thereunto in Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th Day of July 1795
