consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds of good and lawful  
money to me in hand paid by Rickett & Lovelace of the County and  
State aforesaid the Plaintiff whereof I do hereby acknowledge have  
Received paid and Delivered unto these presents according to the  
law Form of Law do Bargain sell and Deliver unto the said Rickett &  
Lovelace four certain Negro slaves over head of cattle, twenty  
head of Hogs, four feather Boxes and furniture three Bedsteads two  
water Dishes, seven Pewter plates one Master Mason and Chest two  
Saddles four horses four hoes three axes, a certain parcel of Carpenter  
tools two Hatches three Pots and Dishes over three running wheels  
to the Carts, one Coffey pot, one Looking Glass, four Robins one Lamp  
one Sailing Lamp and Kerosene, one Still, three Potts one  
Flat Iron to Lavel and to hold all the said Bargained Premises  
unto the said Rickett & Lovelace his Executors & Administrators  
and assigns forever and I the said Leonard Huling for myself my  
Executors and Administrators the said Bargained Premises unto the  
said Rickett & Lovelace his Executors administrators and assigns  
against all Persons shall as will warrant and forever defend  
by these presents the said Article from any Person or Persons from  
laying any Claim therunto witness Whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal this 2<sup>d</sup> Day of July 1795
