

A. N. Tomlin Will

I, A. N. Tomlin of the County of Yadkin and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of this life, do make and declare this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form as follows, I will that my Executor hereinafter to be named, shall sell all my real & personal Estate, collect all debts of every character due my Estate and after selling all my property and collecting all debts due my estate, the amount shall be disposed of and paid out as follows

That my Executor shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of relatives and friends and pay all funeral expenses together with all my just debts.

I will that the amount remaining in the hands of my Executor after paying the above shall be equally divided between the following named persons who are my Nephews & Nieces short and short child, To-wit: Mary Millsaps wife of William Millsaps Emma Gray wife of T. F. Gray both Tomlin daughters of my bro. Perry Tomlin deceased my nephew Perry Tomlin son of Thomas W. Tomlin Mary Summers wife of P. B. Summers & daughter of Thomas W. Tomlin - Jane Tomlin daughter of T. W. Tomlin - Marshall Tomlin Humphrey Tomlin sons of T. W. Tomlin Delia Lazenby Rebecca Lazenby Ellen Lazenby Sallie Lazenby, William Lazenby Thomas Lazenby - Alfred Lazenby Sad Lazenby all children of my deceased sister Elizabeth Lazenby All the living children of Clara and Louisa Summers of Iredell County, names not known, are to share equally with my other Nephews and Nieces herein mentioned except John Summers who has been sufficiently provided for herebefore.

I will bequeath that my Executor pay to David B. White here at last, the sum of Twenty

Five Dollars also pay to Pinkney White the sum of Twenty five Dollars. Also pay to Adeline Summers wife of Pinkney Summers the sum of Twenty five Dollars. The said sum of Twenty five Dollars to be paid by my Executor before the equal division is made between my Nephew and Niece mentioned in article 3rd of this Will.

I do hereby order, constitute & appoint Marshall Tomlin & Nelson Summers Executor of this my last Will & Testament. hereby revoking all former Wills by me made. I further deem that my Executor herein appointed shall at the time of probating this Will file with the Clerk of the Superior Court of Yadkin County a good & sufficient bond for the faithful performance of their duties as executors of this Will. B. Calaway Will

I, B. Calaway do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, as follows after paying all my just debts out of my personal property I will and bequeath my real estate as follows viz.

1st

I will & bequeath to my son Blaine Calaway the following lands adjoining the lands of Dr. Spruce, L. D. Shaw, & others. Beginning at a stump Spruce's corner & run west 19th to corner on Lewis Shaw's line. Then South 3 chains 50 links to a stake. Thence West 19 chains to chestnut oak. Then Southward 19 chains 40 links to a white oak. Then North 3° East 18 chains & 80 links to a stone in old field. Then South 3 1/2° West 19 chains & 60 links to Dr. Wagoner's corner. Then East 19 chains 60 links to Dr. Spruce's corner. Then Northward running with the old line with Spruce's line 49 chains & 80 links to the beginning containing 13 1/2 acres more or less to him Blaine Calaway & his heirs forever in fee simple except as hereinafter stated.

2nd

I will & bequeath to my son Eli Calaway & his heirs in fee, except as hereinafter stated the following lands adjoining Dr. Wagoner, David Wagoner & others, & bounded as follows viz.

Beginning at a white oak in L. D. Shaw's line run South 9 chains & 43 links to a post oak west 8 chains to point of iron. Then South about 72 West 20 chains to David Wagoner's corner. West 7 chains then South 30° West 8 chains to Red Oak. Then West 3 chains 75 links to a hickory. South 15 chains to red oak. East 20 chains & 35 links to white oak. Thence North 20 chains & 70 links to Point of iron. Then East 17 chains to a gate post. Then North 3 1/2° West 18⁸⁰ chains to the beginning containing 12 3/4 acres more or less.

3rd

I will & bequeath to my son Andrew Calaway & his heirs in fee simple except as hereinafter stated the following lands - One tract being the lands I bought of J. Boyant on the waters of Deep Creek bounded as follows viz. Beginning at a stake in Brown's line run East 116 links
