of Sept in the year of our Lord 1847 make certain and
publish this to be my last will an testimony in manner
an form following first that all my just debt be paid
an all making funeral charges bee paid

I will an bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy Dickerson
all of my property of every description my Stock of all
kinds lands an Buildings for her support during her
widowhood or natural life and for the support of my
3 grand children if she should bee the longest living
after her my will is that my land be equally divided
between my two sons I give unto my son James
Dickerson all my land on the South Side of my
deceased branch I give my son John Dickerson
my boar land on the North Side of said branch
also one house to each of my Sons I will my
Grand Son I four Shakespear ten dollars I will
my Grand Son Salem Dickerson five Dollars in
cash I will to my six daughters married Mary
Anna Young Johnson Nancy Weston Carlton Sally
Ernestine Adeline Anna and my Grand Children
Caroline Simpson an she shall have the balance
of my property that remains unvided to be equally divided
between my children an Grand children so I named
and I appoint James an John Dickerson my
executors to this my last will an testimony Gimed
Sealed an delivered in the Year of

I Abraham Reece Senior of Godkin County County and
State of North Carolina being of a perfect mind and
memory Thanks be to god for they same calling unto
me the mortality of my body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die I do ordain this
to be my last will and testament and teaching such worldly
estate as it has pleased God to bestow me in this life
I dispose of in they following manner and form
first First of all it is my will that all my just
debt and funeral charges be first paid

Secondly I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Mary Reece after there is as much of stock sold as
will pay my just debt and the balance I will take
her lifetime or widowhood to support her and family
an also I will my wife Mary Reece one half of
my house hold property to be her life and property
with her wearing cloaths. Thirdly I will my Son
Albert Reece One note of Thiry One dollars and fifty
cents which he gave to his brother Eggle Reece in
they year 1845 which is in my possession besides what
he has had to be his life and property.

Fourthly I will my Son James Reece Seventy Acres
of Land on they lower end of my Plantation
forming of Isle Shoals and Ely Smith provided
that my Son James gives up their note that he
has against me his Father to be his life and property

Fifthly I will my daughter Sarah Reece one feather
Bed and furniture and Bed Sheets one Cow and
Burse my will is that my daughter Sarah shall have
Twenty dollars out of my estate after they decease

of me and my wife to be her life and property
also her maintenance of the place while she remains
single. Sixth I will my Son Eggle Reece fifty five
acres of Land a portion of my son James Land
besides what he has had to be his life and property

Seventhly I will my daughter Banice Shoars ten
dollars besides what she has had to be her life and
property Eighthly I will my Daughter Margaret
Reece One feather Bed and furniture and bed sheets
one Cow one Burse to be her life and property

also it is my will that my Daughter Margaret shall
have a home here while she remains single

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I will my son Abraham Recu all his and
acres of land where I now live with all his improvements
running from Hwy Creek to Willard line and also
you acres of meadow where my son James lives and
my will is that my son Abraham shall take care
maintain his mother her lifetime or widowhood
and after her decease to be his life and property and
also our young yellow horse to be his also my will
is that my two sons James and Abraham Shall
have my Smith tools between them as their own
property after my deceas also our father bed and
furniture to be my sons Abrahams etc also my
will is that Mary Murphy may stay on that land
that she is on as long as she behoves herself so I
shall conclude and appoint my wife Mary Recu
and my son James Recu to be my Executours to
this my last will and testament Testifying and
Confirming this our no other to be my Last will
and testament going forth from under my
hand and seal this day 26th day of January
1852 witness present

make and declare this my last will and testament
in manner and form following that is to say
1st that my Executors herein after named shall provide
for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes
of my friends and pay all funeral expences together
with my just debts

2^d I give and devise to my beloved wife Elizabeth
during her life that portion of the tract of land wherein
James W Hackett and Alexander S Hackett now live it
being apart of the Haudorn tract purchased by myself
of Joseph W Hackett and William St Hackett living and
being in the County of Will, and State of aforesaid bounded
at my death may set forth at her death to be equally
divided between my two sons James & Hunt and
C A Hunt Also I give to my beloved wife amuges
girl named Anna and a note of hand on Joshua Penrod
and Mrs P Waugh for Five hundred Dollars.

The balance of my negroes unless a suitable opportunity offers
that George or Martha & her children be put with their Com-
panions if so the money arising from the sale or sale
of them put upon interest and as my children may
become of age equally divided but if such a
disposition cannot conveniently be made they with will
and Easter unless Easter may wish to live with
some other person if so who she can get to take her
she may live with my wife during her life at her
death to be equally divided between my four children
James & Charles & Francis & and Elizabeth Hunt

3^d I give and bequeath to my two Daughters Anna
& Hunt equally all my interest of the balance of the
tract of Land known by the name of the Haudorn
tract adjoining the before mentioned tract which is
then parts out of five also One thousand Dollars
part of which may be applied to the purchase of
the two slaves if thought by their friends best
4^t My Stock of all kinds Crops Household and
Kitchen Furniture Buggy Waggon & Farming tools
