

In the name of God Amen I Wiley Dickerson of the County of Surry an State of North Carolina being in body but of Sound mind an memory do this the 10th day of Sept in the year of our Lord 1847 make certain and publish this to be my last will an testimony in manner an form following: first that all my just debt be paid an all making funeral charges be paid

I will an bequeath to my third wife Nancy Dickerson all of my property of every description my State of all kinds lands an Arguments for her support during her widowhood or orphaned life and for the support of my 3 Grand Children if she should be the longest liver after her my wife is that my Land be equally divided between my two Sons I gave unto my son James Dickerson all my land on the South Side of my Meadow branch. I gave my son John Dickerson my beam land on the north Side of said branch also one horse to each of my Sons I will my Grand Son Thomas Dickerson ten dollars I will my grand Son Calum Dickerson five Dollars in Cash I will to my six daughters named Mary Penix Fanny Johnson Nancy Vestal Caroline Sales Gerusha Adeline Anselm and my Grand Children Caroline Simpson an Shos Harale to have the balance of my property that remains unwilld to be equally divided between my Children an Grand Children to I named and I appoint James an John Dickerson my executors to this my last will an testimony Signed Sealed an delivered in the Pres of

I Abraham Reese Son of Gadsden County County and State of North Carolina being of a perfect mind an memory Thanks be to God for thy same Calling unto mind they mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do Ordain this to be my last will an testament and teaching such worldly estate as it has Pleased God to give me in this life I dispose of in the following manner and form: First of all it is my will that all my just debt and funeral charges be first paid

Secondly I will an bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary Reese after there is as much of debt sold an will pay my just debt and the balance I will to her her lifetime or widowhood to support her and family an also I will my wife Mary Reese can help by my house hold goods to be her rite and property with her wearing cloaths Thirdly I will my Son Alfred Reese five rods of land one dollar and fifty Cents which he gave to his brother Aquille Reese in the year 1845 which is in my possession beside what he has had to be his rite and property

Fourthly I will my Son James Reese Seventy Acres of Land on the Upper end of my Plantation joining of John Shores and Ely Smith provided that my Son James gives up the note that he has against me his father to be his rite and property

Fifthly I will my daughter Sarah Reese one feather Bed and furniture and Bed Steady one Cow and Burse my will is that my daughter Sarah shall have twenty dollars out of my estate after they decrease of me and my wife to be her rite and property also her maintenance of the place while she remains single Sixthly I will my son Equille Reese fifty five Acres of Land a joining of my son James Land beside what he has had to be his rite and property

Seventhly I will my daughter Carice Shores ten dollars beside what she has had to be her rite and property Eighthly I will my Daughter Margaret Reese one feather Bed and furniture and Burse one Cow one Burse to be her rite and property also it is my will that my Daughter Margaret shall have a home here while she remains single

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I hereby I will my son Abraham Rice an husband
Acres of land where I now live with all my improvements
Running from the Creek to Williams line and also
you acres of meadow where my son James lives and
my will is that my son Abraham shall take care
maintain his mother her lifetime or widowhood
and after her decease to be his wife and property and
also one young yellow horse to be his also my will
is that my two sons James and Abraham shall
have my Smith tools between them as their own
property after my decease also one feather bed and
furniture to be my sons Abrahams wife also my
will is that Mary Murphy may stay on that land
that she is on as long as she behaves herself so I
shall conclude and appoint my wife Mary Rice
and my son James Rice to be my Executors to
this my last will and testament ratifying and
confirming this and no other to be my last will
and testament giving forth from under my
hand and seal this 26th day of January
1852 witness present.

considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do
make and declare this my last will and testament
in manner and form following that is to say
1st That my Executor, herein after named shall provide
for my body a decent burial suit able to the wishes
of my friends and pay all funeral expences together
with my just debts

2nd I give and devise to my beloved wife Elizabeth
during her life that portion of the tract of land whereon
James W Hackett and Alexander S Hackett now live it
being a part of the Haddon tract purchased by myself
of Joseph W Hackett and William H Hackett lying and
being in the County of Wilkes and State of North Carolina
as my Deed may set forth at her death to be equally
divided between my two sons James B Hunt and
C A Hunt Also I gave to my beloved wife an negro
girl named Mira and a note of hand on Joshua Pennel
and Wm P Waugh for Five hundred Dollars.

The balance of my negroes unless a suitable opportunity offers
that George or Martha or her children be put with their com-
panions if so the money arising from the sale or sale
of them put upon interest and as my children may
become of age equally divided but if such a
disposition cannot conveniently be made they with wife
and Easter (unless Easter may wish to live with
some other person if so who she can get to take her
she may live with my wife during her life at her
death to be equally divided between my four children

3rd I give and bequeath to my two daughters F A and
E Hunt equally all my interest of the balance of the
tract of Land known by the name of the Haddon
tract adjoining the before mentioned tract which is
then part out of five also One thousand Dollars
apart of which may be applied to the purchase of
the two shares if thought by their friends best
4th My Stock of all kinds Crops House hold and
Kitchen Furniture Buggy Waggons & Farming tools
