of the County of Gaston and State of North
Carolina being of sound mind and memory
and considering the frailty of this transitory
life, do make establish and ordain this
to be my last will and testament in

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
the house and plantation where I now
live, together with the fifty acres that
I bought of Isaac Wagoner
during her natural life, also all my
property except the youngest child
that I give and bequeath to my son

death and equally divided between
my children. Also I give and
bequeath to my daughter Sarah one
cow black heifer and lastly I
appoint and ordain George Long
to be my executor to the my
last will and testament this
the 5th day of October 1867
