That is to say, first that after the departure of said A. W. Turner & wife Martha A. Turner, I give and bequeath to my son E. W. Turner my, some tract or parcel of land and known as lot No. 2. Beginning at a stone on the bank of the Fadkin River and the N.E. corner of lot No. 1 and runs South 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 13 chs & 43 links to a stone, then west bearing 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 5 chs & 50 links to a stone in Spaniards line. Then South 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 4 chs to a wild cherry. Then South about 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. on his line 31 chs & 56 links to a stone the dividing line.
