Item 1"

I Alexander Hall of the County of  
yadkin and State of North Carolina  
do make publish and declare this to be  
my last Will and Testament.

I will and bequeath to my beloved wife  
Jane Hall all of my Household and Kitchen  
furniture consisting of two feather Bed  
and Bed Stretcher and covering one Braemore one  
Cupboard and wane all my chairs and tables  
one clock and Cook Stove all the cook  
ing utensile one Bay Horse two Cows and  
one calf. Nine head of Hogs and all the  
Money at hand and one Wagon and gear  
and all my Plows and Hoes Mattocks  
and all other tools not mentioned that  
may be at hand and the tract of Land  
on which I live containing Thirtysix  
and a half acres which is the Land  
my wife Jane Hall drawed into the  
possession of her Father and Mother Land  
and I had to pay back Twenty six dollars  
and also the tract of Land I bought of  
Henry Blownman containing Thirteen acres  
more or less and adjoining the tract on  
which I now live and also the tract  
of Land I bought of Tyne & Harrell con-  
taining Thirteen acres more or less all  
of said tracts of Land lying and being  
in the County of yadkin on Tumen  
Creek and I also will and bequeath unto  
my beloved wife Jane Hall all the grain  
of any description that may be at hand  
and all other property not herein before  
mention'd of any description that may be  
at hand

Item 2"

I will and bequeath unto Thos. Lang the  
sum of Thirtysix dollars to be paid to him  
after the death of my wife Jane Hall.

I hereby constitute and appoint J. G. Hunt  
Executor to this my last will and Testament  
This the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1814
