Item 1

I Alexander Hall of the County of
Yadkin and State of North Carolina
do make publick and declare this to be
my last will and Testament.

I will and bequeath to my beloved wife
Jane Hall all of my Household and Kitchen
in furniture consisting of two feather Beds
and Bed Stord and covering one Brazen one
Copper and want all my chairs and tables
one clock and Look Glass all the cook
ing utensils one Bay Horse two Goats and
one calf. Nine head of Hogs and all the
Money on hand. and one woman and gear
and all my Plows and Axes Mattocks
and all other tools not mentioned that
may be on hand and the tract of Land
on which I live containing thirty seven
and a half Acres which is the Land
my wife Jane Hall deeded in the
division of her Father and Mother's Land
and I had to pay back Twenty Six dollars
and also the Tract of Land I bought of
Henry Plowman containing Twelve acres
more or less and adjoining the Tract on
which I now live and also the Tract
of Land I bought of Tyne Harvill con-
taining Twelve acres more or less all
of said Tracts of Land lying and being
in the County of Yadkin on Turners
Creek. and I also will and bequeath unto
my beloved wife Jane Hall all the Drains
of any description that may be on hand
and all other property not heretofore
mentioned of any description that may be
on hand

Item 2

I will and bequeath unto Thos. Lang the
sum of Thirty dollars to be paid to him
after the death of my wife Jane Hall.

Item 3

I hereby constitute and appoint J. G. Hunt
Executor to this my last will and Testament
this the 20th day of August A.D. 1819
