I Alfred Long being of sound mind and memory do make public and declare the following to be my last ^{will} and testament to wit,

Item 1st I will and devise to my beloved wife Mary Long the tract of land on which I now reside, adjoining the lands of Chick Maller - J. F. Long, J. O. Long and others, containing about 14 ^{acres} being comprised of three different tracts, purchased of three different persons during her natural life, and after her death to be equally divided between my two daughters Martha P. Royall and Nancy E. Weatherman and their heirs.

Item Second I will and devise to my daughter Nancy E. Weatherman the tract of land known as the Rock place, adjoining the lands of P. H. Holcomb, Bobber Spess, Samuel Holcomb & others, it being about of the W. H. Holcomb lands during her life, and after her death to her children and their heirs,

Item Third I will and devise to my daughter Martha P. Royall one lot or tract of land at Chestnut Ridge containing one acre more or less, adjoining the lands of Mrs. Elizabeth Holcomb & others, it being the lot purchased from Robert Hunt,

Item 4th I will and devise to my two daughters Mary E. Weatherman and Nancy E. Weatherman a lot or tract of land at Chestnut Ridge containing two acres of more or less adjoining the lands of Elizabeth Holcomb and others purchased by me from John Holcomb to be equally divided between them,

Item 5th I will and bequeath to my beloved wife personal property to the value of one hundred dollars to be selected by her, to be valued at a fair price by two disinterested men, and to be

selected by her and one by my Executors herein after named. After delivering to my wife Mary the personal property bequeathed to her, it is my will and desire that my Executors herein after named sell the remainder of my personal property at public auction for cash after due advertisement and out of the proceeds of the sale first pay my debts and burial expenses and then pay to my daughter Martha P. Royall one hundred dollars, and my two sons J. F. Long and J. O. Long each twenty five dollars, and if any surplus remains after paying the expenses of administration my estate it must be equally divided between my three daughters Mary E. Weatherman Martha P. Royall and Mary E. Weatherman.

Item 6th I hereby appoint my two sons J. F. Long and J. O. Long Executors to all intents and purposes to carry out and execute this my last will and testament, hereby revoking and declaring void all other wills and testaments heretofore by me made by me,
