my last will and testament in manner and form following  
First. I resign my soul into the hands of Almighty God I  
hoping and believing in a remission of my sins by the merits  
of Jesus Christ, and my body I commit to the earth to be  
buried at the discretion of my executor herein after named  
And my worldly estate I give and devise as follows  
Item First. I will that out of my estate all my just be paid  
Item Second. I will and bequeath to my beloved wife  
Celia all the residue of my property personal and  
real to possess and enjoy during her natural life or  
whilst she shall remain my lawful widow

Item Third. It is my will and desire and I hereby  
desire the same that at the death or marriage of my  
that at that event an equal division of all my estate  
except such as may be herein after otherwise disposed  
of be made and that the one half be given and  
devoted to the American Bible Society as a donation  
in respect to the elegance and great good effected  
by that institution. Item fourth. And my will stands  
I do hereby expressly declare and ordain that at the  
death of my wife my negro boy John be emancipated  
and released from bondage forever

And I do hereby constitute and appoint  
my said wife Celia sole executor of this my last  
will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal the 15<sup>th</sup> day of March  
A.D. 1851
