in the house where I now live, also all money
judgments, notes and accounts which is due
me to collect and use as she sees proper during
her life and the balance (if any) at her death
to go to my son J. M. Speer if he is living if not
living to go to his children

Art 3rd I appoint my son J. M. Speer my executor
to this my last will & Testament without giving
bond & Surety.
