

Will of S. B. Harding

I Squire B. Harding, do make this my last and Testament in witness and form following.

Item 1st. It is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid. Item second After the payment of my debts I will and bequeath unto my nephew Samuel Brewster two hundred dollars.

Item third. I will and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary B. Harding one third of the remainder of my entire estate during her natural life or widowhood. Item fourth I will and bequeath unto my nephew John Long one third of the remainder of my entire estate.

Item fifth. I will and bequeath unto my nephew Born Stedman one third of the remainder of my estate.

Item sixth my will and desire is that John Long take charge of Born Stedman's portion of my estate and act as his Guardian.

Item seventh my will and desire is that if my wife should die again that her part of my estate be equally divided between my nephew John Long and Born Stedman.

Item eighth. I do hereby constitute and appoint my nephew John Long Executor of this my last will and testament. Witness my hand and seal 21st March 1888.
