of the first moneys that may come into her
hands belonging to my estate
Second, I leave and bequeath to my beloved
sister Emilie Kinney all my personal property
of every kind and description and so hereinafter located
Third I give and devise to my beloved sister
Emilie Kinney, all my real property whenever
located Fourth, I hereby constitute and appoint
my beloved sister Emilie Kinney, my
lawful executor to all intents and purposes
to execute this my last will and testament
according to the true intent and meaning
of the same and every part thereof hereby
revoking and declaring utterly void all
wills and testaments by me heretofore made
for witness whereof I the said Bettie Brown
do hereunto set my hand and seal, this the
27th day of October, 1913.
