I Caroline Harris of the aforesaid County and State, being of sound mind, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this to be my last will and Testament. First I appoint as my Executors J. H. Hurt and M. H. Bray of the County and State above named and have delivered all my assets to them and they shall dispose of my Property both Personal and real to the best advantage for all the heirs and apply the proceeds as follows after all expense is paid: Then I give and bequeath one thousand dollars, \$1000.00 to Annie Harris, and Ida Harris Wicks both at the State Hospital at Morganton N.C. to be divided equal between them and so that the remaining part of my estate shall be divided in three parts, and I will that Uriel Ester Brown my Grand daughter shall have $\frac{2}{3}$ two thirds of one third's above named; and that the remaining part of my estate shall then be divided in three equal parts and that John J. Harris shall have one third's of same.

William Harris one third's of same and Mary Jane Southard one third's to her only use and behoof as long as she lives and then to her bodily heirs.
